Shelter Tours involve a walkthrough of our facility, including in front of the dog kennels, cat building, and pocket pet area, and can include presentations and time to visit with the animals if desired. Group tours must be booked at least one week in advance. Some groups may request to add a community service element, or educational presentation to their shelter tour.
