After Care

It is normal for your pet to be tired and sore for up to 24 hours after receiving vaccinations. Please do not give your pet any medications unless instructed to do so by a licensed veterinarian.

Although very rare, some pets can have a serious reaction and require immediate medical treatment. Please keep a close eye on your pet for the first 24 hours. IT IS NOT NORMAL FOR YOUR PET TO HAVE SYMPTOMS SUCH AS DIARRHEA, FACIAL SWELLING OR HIVES. These could be a sign of a serious vaccine reaction. If any of these symptoms occur within 12 hours after vaccination, please call us at (808) 877-3680 x222; our facility will be open until 6:00 pm. If you feel that your pet is having a severe or life-threatening reaction and you cannot reach us, please contact your veterinarian. The Maui Humane Society will not be held liable for a vaccine reaction in your pet.
