Position: We are seeking an experienced licensed **Veterinarian with an interest in shelter medicine, high volume spay neuter and community medicine.** We are adding a fourth veterinarian to our team so that we can expand our community outreach services, while continuing to practice the highest quality of shelter medicine and surgery. Working a 4 day workweek, the right person will prioritize work life balance and share a passion for increasing access to care and making a difference for the animals and people on the island of Maui.

Who We Are

Maui Humane Society has been serving the community for over 65 years and is Maui's only open admission shelter. Maui Humane Society provides Animal Management and 24/7 Animal Emergency Response services to the County of Maui, accepting more than 4,000 animals from the community annually. The organization's Wings of Aloha transfer program places over 800 animals into adoption-guaranteed care on the mainland each year, and our extensive volunteer foster network provides care and shelter to over 2,000 animals annually. Other programs are dedicated to providing affordable spay/neuter and medical services for community animals, building partnerships to manage community cat populations, and giving those experiencing hardship the resources necessary to keep pets in loving homes.
